

Charity Gift Aid Declaration Form – single donation

You can boost your donation by 25p with every £1 you donate with Gift Aid

Gift Aid can be reclaimed by the charity from the tax you pay for the current tax year as an **individual** (not business). Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer but will not be sold to a third party. It would help immensely if you are agreeable.
